Equity Members

Voting Rights

May serve on the Board

Pay one-time equity payment of \$400

\$300 annual dues

\$100 annual maintenance fee

Granted use of tennis courts

Tend to be local homeowners

Sponsored Members

No-voting Rights

May not serve on the Board

\$375 annual dues

\$100 annual maintenance fee

Granted use of tennis courts

How do I become a Member?

1. Choose the Type of Membership that is best for your family?
2. Complete the appropriate Membership Application and mail to RFSRC

3. Review the Pool Rules and By Laws
4. If you have children, you will also need to complete the Disciplinary Contract (found in the Membership section).
5. If you have children ages 10-17, you will need to complete the Medical Release Form in order for them to be eligible to swim without parental supervision (found in the Membership section)

Can my older children swim without parental supervision?

Children ages 10-17 are permitted to swim without parental supervision if they have signed a Disciplinary Contract and have a Medical Release Form on file.

How do Members access the tennis courts?

Members should contact the Tennis Committee Chair for the code to access the tennis courts.

Who should Members contact if I have a concern about the pool?

Members should contact a Board Member with any concerns about the pool.
